The Navajo Nation Capital Project Management Department (“NNCPMD”) of the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development, hereby issues this invitation for: REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) PACKAGE “For the procurement of Traditional Design/Build Services for a Single Contractor for the set-up of Pre-Manufactured Modular Buildings, which services shall include qualified: Design/Construction/Manufacture/ of the modular buildings, Transporting delivery services, Site design with Storm water Pollution Prevention Plan/prep and civil engineering services, Infrastructure design/prep, construction, and Construction Management services with all required permit. for Crownpoint Department of Behavioral Health Services (DBHS) Crownpoint, New Mexico, within the Navajo Nation.”

A PRE-SUBMITTAL MEETING shall take place at Crownpoint DBHS Building 11am MDST on April 04, 2018; Interested Parties may obtain a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) Proposals Package at the Pre-submittal meeting. RSOQ must be submit sealed, Labeled “CROWNPOINT DBHS PROJECT NNDCD/ Capital Project Management Department Proposals before 3:00 pm MDST, **April 26, 2018**, to George Hubbard, Project Manager, Navajo Nation CPMD, Administration Building No. 2, Window Rock Blvd., Window Rock, Arizona, Proposals (RSOQ) packages must be HAND-DELIVERED IN PERSON as shown above date/time - no emailed or faxed Proposals shall be accepted.

This Procurement is being conducted pursuant to all applicable Navajo Nation Laws and Regulations, including the proposal scoring procedures of the Navajo Business Opportunity Act. The Selected Professional Design/Build Company must be duly licensed within the state in which services are being provided for and shall be expected to comply with all applicable Navajo Nation Laws and Regulations pertaining to the Project, and to the Contract. The Navajo Nation reserves the right to disqualify from consideration

any proposals, and/or to waive any minor irregularities in proposals received.

Purpose of Form
