The Navajo Nation Capital Projects Management Department (CPMD) issues this Invitation to Bid (ITB), for Warehouse Renovation work at four (4) sites in New Mexico. These sites are at four locations: Church Rock, Crownpoint, Kirtland, and Mexican Springs. All four of these warehouses are owned by the Navajo Nation Food Distribution Program (FDP), and sit on Navajo Nation owned land.
