SUBJECT: New Travel and Pcard Policies

Given the difficulties over the last couple of weeks it is easy to overlook that the Budget and Finance Committee had approved the revised Travel and Pcard policy (BFJA-04-20) which will apply for all **External** and **General** funded programs of the Navajo Nation. However, notwithstanding the challenges faced on the Navajo Nation, it is still important to remind people and programs that the new Travel and Pcard policies are in effect as of **April 01, 2020**. Prior to implementation, the Office of the Controller allowed for a transitional period so that programs could adjust and implement procedures and/or guidelines to account for the new policies. The transitional period has passed and the new policies for Travel and Pcard are in effect as of **April 01, 2020**.

Also, Contract Accounting section will adopt and implement the new policy guidelines as part of their work. There will be **no compromise regarding the implementation** of the policies. Any travel and/or Pcard activity beginning **April 01, 2020** will be governed by the new policies.
