The NN Fish and Wildlife/Animal Control Program of the Division of Natural Resources is currently soliciting sealed bids for the purchase of 4 vehicles for the program to use. The Animal Control Program has total of 11 field staff and currently have only 7 vehicles that are use for the field work. ACP staff responds to priority calls such as animal bites, livestock damage and unwanted pick-ups across the Navajo Nation. The ACP provides vaccinations such rabies, canine distemper, feline(cat) distemper, and deworm for pets. Currently, Animal Control Officer are doubling up on vehicles, with new 4 vehicle they be able respond to more animal control service calls across the Navajo Nation.

Therefore, the Animal Control Program is requesting four (4) Heavy Duty Pick-up trucks-2024 GMC Sierra 2500HD (TK20743 4WD Crew Cab 159" Pro (3). Sierra HD pro Safety includes (LIEU) Forward Collision Alert (UE4) following distance indicator, (UKJ) Front pedestrian braking, IntelliBeam, Lane Departure Warning, Buckle to drive and Automatic Emergency braking.

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Must be authorized and fully certified licensed automotive dealership that meets all the standards and qualification from the vehicle manufacture in terms of facilities, equipment, parts, tools and trained technicians to handle all required services. Vehicle must be delivered in a timely manner as bid evaluation will be based on most responsive bid in accordance to specifications and criteria.

Should the Bidder be verified as being on the Navajo Nation Business Regulatory Listing, they will have an advantage. However, this does not guaranteed BID award. BID price shall be F.O.B. Window Rock and to the designated delivery point at Fleet Management Department. Vehicles shall be delivered to the Navajo Nation free from any purchase money or lien or security interest. The manufacturers published warranty for the vehicle shall apply to all vehicles purchased by Navajo Nation Fish and Wildlife/Animal Control Program.

The Navajo Nation is not bound to enter into a contract under Invitation for Bids and may issue a subsequent Invitation for Bids for the same goods.

Since the Navajo Nation is a Sovereign government all contracts entered shall comply with, all Navajo Nation law, rules and regulations, as well as applicable federal laws,

rules and regulations.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE PROCUREMENT

Bid shall be effective on date of award and the availability of funds will determine the number of vehicle amenities to be purchased, and additional procurement for like kind and quality of vehicles also qualifies for bid price. Navajo Nation Fleet Management personnel will make on-site visits to either manufacturer's/ Bidders facilities, as needed, to ensure compliance with specifications are met, of approve any deviations, if necessary. The Navajo Nation Fleet Management will receive, at time of delivery of vehicles, all pertinent documents necessary for titling and licensing vehicles, documents include Manufacturer's statement of Origin and Odometer statement. Only Navajo Nation Fleet will be responsible for registering all vehicles through the Navajo Nation Property Management Department. Payment will be made after delivery of the vehicle and receipt of all pertinent documents, including invoice. Full payment is to be made no Later than 15 days following receipt of all pertinent documents,

including invoice. Temporary license sticker must accompany delivery if no release
Manufacturer Statement of Origin is included as part of the documents: and will delay
timely payment.

SPECIFICATIONS

See the following attachments for specifications for each vehicle and quantity required,
including any exhibits. Bid price must meet minimum specifications or exceeded
minimum specifications. Bid must note any exceptions.

CLOSING REMARKS

The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government and all contracts entered into as a result of
this RFP shall comply with Navajo Nation Law, rules and regulations, including the
Navajo Preference in Employment Act, and all applicable federal laws, rules and
regulations.

Instructions to offerers to visibly mark on the outside of the proposal package, if applicable,
the offerers priority status under the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act. It is the
responsibility of the offerer to identify themselves as certified under the Navajo Nation
Business Opportunity Act.

Payment Procedures established by the Division of Finance shall be adhered to and are to
begin whenever goods are delivered and accepted.

The BIDs will Open on August 2, 2023, and close by August 10, 2023 at 5 p.m. RFP's
received after the specified time, will not be accepted. Please all adequate time for delivery.
If using a courier service, the dealership is responsible for ensuring the delivery will be made
directly to the required location. Please include any applicable fees an 6% Navajo Nation Tax
(The Navajo Nation does not pay federal or state taxes)

**NAVAJO NATION CERTIFICATION
Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and
Contracting Eligibility**

1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - i. Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract,
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - iii. Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
