The Navajo Nation Facilities Maintenance Department (here after referred to as FMD) invites interested Professional Service Companies to submit proposals for the Navajo Nation Facilities Condition and Needs Assessment (FCNA). This contract shall begin September 10, 2023 through May 24, 2024 for a period of 9 calendar months.

The intent of this request for proposal to provide a comprehensive and professional Facilities Condition and Needs Assessment (FCNA) services for all facilities listed under the Navajo Nation Facilities Maintenance Department Maintenance Listing.

PRE-BID MEETING FOR ALL PROSPECTIVE ENTITIES WILL TAKE PLACE ON AUGUST 16, 2023 AT 10:00 A.M. THE DESIGNATED MEETING PLACE IS AT THE NAVAJO NATION FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT, 2431 NORTH ROUTE 12, FORT DEFIANCE, ARIZONA 86504.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS DUE: AUGUST 18, 2023

The FMD is accepting proposals from qualified professional service companies to provide the Navajo Nation Facilities Condition and Needs Assessment Services. The award of the contract shall be determined by the FMD.

Responses to this RFP shall be submitted to the Navajo Nation Facilities Maintenance Department at the date and time noted above. All proposals must be clearly marked RFP – NN FACILITIES CONDITION AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT SERVICES. No verbal, telephonic, emailed, or faxed responses shall be considered. No verbal, telephonic, emailed, or faxed corrections, deletions, or additions to any response shall be accepted. The FMD reserves the right to reject any or all responses, and to waive any or all formalities in connection with this request. Any responses received after the above scheduled due date and time shall not be accepted or considered.

1. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

Any subsequent contract award associated with this RFP is contingent upon the availability of funds to the FMD for this project. If funds are not available, any agreement resulting from this RFP shall become void and of no force and effect. FMD reserves the right to negotiate the overall contract price based on the availability of funds.

2. AGREEMENT

The FMD, upon mutually agreed to and acceptable terms and conditions with the successful responder/consultant, shall enter into a formal agreement for a mutually agreed to fee and period of time. The FMD reserves the right, subject to mutual agreement with the successful responder/consultant, to extend the terms of this agreement, at the proposed rate, for a mutually agreed upon period of time.

3. CANCELLATION OF AGREEMENT

The FMD reserves the right to cancel any contract/agreement, at any time, with thirty (30) days prior written notice to the consultant, should any of the following conditions exist:

- Funds are not appropriated by the FMD for continuance of this agreement.
- The FMD, through changes in its requirements, method of operation, or program operation no longer has a need for the service.

4. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The selected entity, upon receiving authorization to proceed, shall be required to deliver an insurance certificate in amounts, companies, and terms acceptable to the FMD.

The entity selected shall provide evidence of insurance coverage from a company or companies with an A.M. Best rating of A- (VII) or better. Such insurance will protect and indemnify the FMD from claims which may arise out of or result from any obligation under this agreement, whether such obligations are the Contractor's or those of a subcontractor or any person or entity directly or indirectly employed by said Contractor. Minimum coverage is as follows:

- 1. Workers Compensation: Consultant shall provide workers compensation and employer's liability insurance that complies with the regulations of the Navajo Nation with limits no less than \$100,000 each accident by bodily injury; \$100,000 each accident by disease and a policy limit of \$500,000.
 - 2. Commercial General Liability Insurance: Consultant shall provide commercial general liability insurance policy that includes products, operations and completed operations (with no exclusion for sexual abuse or molestation). Limits should be at least: Bodily injury & property damage with an occurrence limit of \$1,000,000: Personal & advertising injury limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence: General aggregate limit of \$2,000,000 (other than products and completed operations): Products and completed operations aggregate limit of \$2,000,000. The policy shall name the FMD as an additional insured. Such coverage will be provided on an occurrence basis and will be primary and shall not contribute in any way to any insurance or self-insured retention carried by the FMD. Such coverage shall contain a broad form contractual liability endorsement or similar wording within the policy form.
- 3. Commercial Automobile Insurance: Consultant shall provide commercial automobile insurance for any owned autos (symbol 1 or equivalent) in the amount of \$1,000,000 each accident covering bodily

injury and property damage on a combined single limit basis. Such coverage shall also include hired and non-owned automobile coverage.

4. Include a statement that no conflicts of interest exist in the provision of the services.

Umbrella Liability Insurance: Consultant shall provide an umbrella liability policy in excess (without restriction or limitation) of those limits described in items (A) through (C). Such policy shall contain limits of liability in the amount of \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate which may be amended during the term of the contract if deemed reasonable and customary by the FMD at the sole cost and expense of the Contractor. As to the insurance required, the insurer(s) and/or their authorized agents shall provide the FMD with certificates of insurance prior to execution of the agreement by the FMD, describing the coverage.

5. AWARDING THE SERVICES

The services shall be awarded to the consultant whose qualifications are deemed to best provide the services desired, taking into account the requirements, terms and conditions contained in the request for proposals and the criteria for evaluating proposals.

9. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Navajo Nation FMD is requesting proposal from qualified consultants for comprehensive FCNA services and intends to contract with a consultant to system design, project build, and project launch a web-based database to analyze and track the Navajo Nation building assets and have the consultant create a data base that meets the needs of the Program.

The Scope of Work shall include, but not limited to:

- 1. Identify and document current conditions of all existing Nation-owned structures (Appendix A, B, C, and D), including a procedure to reconcile the total existing building between Office of the Controller Property Section-FMIS system, Division of General Services FMD and Division of General Services Risk Management Program.
- 2. Assess condition of the building structurally, sustainability, occupancy condition and safety issues.
- 3. Develop a web-based tracking system for the total 1400 building which is expandable for future building acquisitions including a single web dash board showing the building asset listings.
- 4. The web-based system must interface with JD Edwards FMIS and other software programs capable of uploading and extracting of building data base and should be interactive with multiple end-user access.
- 5. The database should be capable of following but not limited to tracking new building assets, transfer of assets, asset location and relocation, property numbers, serial numbers, procurement related data for assets, track depreciation value and warranty information.
- 6. Take and attach photos to document building assets
- 7. Reconciliation and verification of buildings between Navajo Nation Divisions, Departments and Programs.
- 8. Develop a Building Acquisition Policy; inclusive a summation of Rules for all data sets of Office of the Controller Property, Division of General Services FMD and Division of General Services Risk management.
- 9. Develop a Building Replacement plan for the Navajo Nation.
- 10. The database is required be user-friendly, and must have multi-user access with unique login information.
- 11. Develop a desk top manual and conduct training to FMD staff on database maintenance.

10. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS AND FORMAT

The following material is to be included in all responses and received by the date and time noted above in order for any entity to be considered:

Technical Proposal Section

Section I: Company Cover Letter/Executive Summary

This section should state the size of the entity, the type of entity, the entity's background, and the location and/or office from which the work on this project shall be performed. In no more than three (3) pages, the Cover Letter and Executive Summary shall include:

- 1. The names of the key members of the consultant team
- 2. A summary of the consultant's Facility Condition and Needs Assessment experience and qualifications of consultant and consultant team members.
- 3. An acknowledgement of receiving any addendum(s) to the RFP document sent out by the Nation.

Section II: Experience and Qualifications of Consultant/Team Members

Provide detail relating to the experience and qualifications of the members of the team, including an organizational chart showing all key personnel who will be assigned to this project. Submit brief resumes demonstrating the training, experience, and other qualifications of the key personnel who will be assigned to this project.

Consultant should further document expertise by including the information regarding the following:

- 1. Facility and Property Condition Assessments to include applicable facility inventory use, type and area (square feet).
- 2. Experience of proposed consultant team working together as a team on similar scope and type of projects.
- 3. Understanding of operations, activities, staffing needs and maintenance of facilities.
- 4. Experience with the use of life-cycle cost and value engineering.
- 5. Any other information that would assist the review team in understanding the consultant team's capacity to efficiently and effectively complete the project.

Section III: References

Include a list of references and contact information in the response. This list should include past and present clients as outlined in Experience above, including names and telephone numbers of contact people.

Section IV: Specific Approach, Sample Reports and Management Plan

The consultant shall demonstrate its capacity to deliver comprehensive professional FCNA services. Consultant shall outline methodology and logistics capable of meeting the goals outlined in the FCNA scope, as well as provide a proposed work plan for development and implementation of the FCNA as described in the scope of work.

Clearly outline the delivery schedule and timeline of each component of the project including specific dates should be used assuming an award to this RFP and an executed agreement. Consultant shall be prepared to begin work within two (2) weeks of the Notice to Proceed. Completion of this assessment in a timely fashion will be a factor in scoring this section. Including in the proposed scheduling a Gantt chart or schematic representation of the delivery timeline with pertinent milestones and events is required in this section.

the right to make a selection based on interview process, qualifications, experience in providing similar services elsewhere, overall responsiveness to the requirements of this RFP; and to negotiate a contract/agreement with the Consultant.
