The purpose of the Scope of Work is to define and establish the scope of services necessary, and the contract shall be awarded based on the lowest responsible bid and responsive bid package. The bid shall meet the needs of the Navajo Nation Department of Child Care and Development, for the removal and disposal of all the existing metal stairs, metal wheelchair ramps, existing concrete footings, existing vegetation, existing wooden porch coverings, and all debris. Also, to install new reinforced concrete pads, new reinforced concrete landings, new prefabricated aluminum wheelchair ramps, new prefabricated aluminum non-slip stairs, new aluminum staircase and aluminum wheelchair ramps shall have two hand railings located on the inside for adult and children height, and new metal porch structures, new metal panel deck covering, and new rain gutters on the new metal porch structures, as required at the following locations; Alchini Nizhoni I Child Care Center – Building No. 4244, Alchini Nizhoni II Child Care Center – Building No. 4245, Ft. - 2. The licensed contractor shall provide a written workplan schedule that allows for the least amount of disruption of the child care operations.
- 3. The licensed contractor shall be responsible for daily and final cleanup of all the site locations listed above, in accordance with the scope of work.
- 4. The licensed contractor shall at all times adhere to and be incompliance with any and all applicable Federal, State, Navajo Nation, local regulations, statues, and laws.
- 5. The licensed contractor shall submit materials submittals, structural plans, color selection for the new metal porch structure, and new metal panel deck covering, to be approved by the DCCD.
- 6. The licensed contractor shall provide professional workmanship for the removal and disposal of all the existing metal stairs, metal ramps, existing concrete, existing vegetation, existing porch coverings, and all debris as required at all site locations listed above.
- 7. The licensed contractor shall replace damaged building siding panels and material when the existing porch covering is removed. The building siding panel color shall match the existing building siding panel color.
- 8. The licensed contractor shall provide professional workmanship to install new reinforced concrete pad, new reinforced concrete landings, new prefabricated aluminum wheelchair ramps, new prefabricated aluminum non-slip stairs, two hand railings for adult and children height, and new metal porch structures as required at all site locations listed above.

- 9. The licensed contractor shall install new prefabricated aluminum wheelchair ramps and new prefabricated aluminum non-slip stairs as required at all site locations listed above.
- 10. The licensed contractor shall install a new metal porch covering structure, with new metal panels deck covering the entire landing, ramps, and stairs areas.
- 11. The new porch structure and new metal panel deck covering shall have a positive slope for positive drainage.
- 12. The licensed contractor shall install ramp runs, with a slope no steeper than the most stringent codes and standards.
- 13. The licensed contractor shall install ramp runs, with two handrails on each side for adult and children height, shall be a minimum of 36 inches (36") wide.
- 14. The licensed contractor shall install all landings, concrete and porch, shall be a minimum of 60 inches by 60 inches (60" x 60") minimum.
- 15. The licensed contractor shall install edge protection, on each side of the ramps runs and each side of the ramp landings.
- 16. The licensed contractor shall install a new reinforced concrete sidewalk from the new reinforced concrete landings to the existing concrete sidewalks.

 - d. The licensed contractor shall prepare the sub grade for the required new reinforced concrete pads and for the new required size reinforced concrete landings.
 - e. The licensed contractor shall calculate the required thickness of the new reinforced concrete pads.
 - f. The licensed contractor shall pour a new reinforced concrete pad, for the entire size of the new stairs and wheelchair ramp.
 - g. The licensed contractor shall pour the appropriate size new reinforced concrete landings and connect concrete sidewalk to the existing sidewalk.
 - h. The licensed contractor shall install two (2) new prefabricated aluminum wheelchair ramp, new prefabricated aluminum non-slip stairs, with two hand railings located on the inside for adult and children height, and metal porch structure and new metal panel deck covering as required at the main front entrance/exit and at the north employee entrance/exit.
 - i. The licensed contractor shall install a new metal structure and new metal panels, for the new metal porch structures and the new metal deck coverings for the entire landing, wheelchair ramp, and stair areas. The new porch structures and new metal panel deck coverings shall be connected to the building and have a positive slope for positive drainage. Installation of three (3) new metal structures and new metal panels shall be at the main front entrance/exit, employee north entrance/exit, and playground south entrance/exit.
 - j. The licensed contractor shall install new seamless rain gutters on the three (3) new metal porch structures, with down spouts, and concrete splash blocks, to direct water away from the building.
 - k. The licensed contractor shall secure and anchor new prefabricated aluminum ramp, new prefabricated aluminum non-slip stairs, and three (3) new metal porch structures to the new reinforced concrete pad.
- 2. Ft. Defiance Child Care Center Building No. 4006

- a. The licensed contractor shall visit the site location and take all measurements of the door heights for required slopes.
- b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing metal stairs and wheelchair ramp.

When the existing wooden porch structure and covering is removed from the modular building, the licensed contractor shall inspect the condition of the existing horizontal wood frame support on the existing side of the modular building, for damage due to water moisture and structural cracks deterioration.

3. Greasewood Child Care Center – Building No. 4007

- a. The licensed contractor shall visit the site location and take all measurements of the door heights for required slopes.
- b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the exiting metal stairs and wheelchair ramp.
- c. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing vegetation, existing concrete stair, and existing concrete footings.

- d. The licensed contractor shall prepare the sub grade for the required new reinforced concrete pads, and for the required size new reinforced concrete landings.
- e. The licensed contractor shall calculate the required thickness of the new concrete pads.

4. Hogback Child Care Center, Building No. 4010

- b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing metal stairs and wheelchair ramp. Remove wheelchair ramp handrails only to end of wheelchair ramp, railing in front of in the ground grease trap will remain.
- c. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing vegetation, existing concrete footings, and two (2) existing wooden porch coverings.
- d. When the existing wooden porch structure and covering is removed from the modular building, the licensed contractor shall inspect the condition of the existing horizontal wood frame support on the existing side of the modular building, for damage due to water moisture and structural cracks deterioration.

5. Kii Doo Baa II Child Care Center, Building No. 4011

- a. The licensed contractor shall visit the site location and take all measurements of the door heights for required slopes.
- b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing metal stairs and wheelchair ramp.
- c. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing vegetation, existing concrete pads, and existing four (4) wooden porch coverings.
- d. When the existing wooden porch structures and porch coverings is removed from the modular building, the licensed contractor shall inspect the condition of the existing horizontal wood frame supports on the existing side of the modular building, for damage due to water moisture and structural cracks deterioration.
- e. If the existing horizonal wood frame supports are damaged, the contractor shall remove the existing wood frame supports, including fastener materials and disposal of all damaged materials.
- f. The licensed contractor shall install new wood frame supports, new fasteners, new materials, and match the existing wood frame support dimensions.
- g. The contractor shall install new metal panels, and the new metal panel shall be the same color as the existing building metal panels.

The new porch structures and new metal panel deck coverings shall be connected to the building and have a positive slope for positive drainage. The installation of four (4) new metal structures and new metal panels shall be at all entrances/exits.
- o. The licensed contractor shall install new seamless rain gutters on the four (4) new metal porch structures, with down spouts, and concrete splash blocks, to direct water away from the building.
- p. The licensed contractor shall secure and anchor new modular aluminum wheelchair ramps, new aluminum non-slip stairs, and four (4) new metal porch structures to the new reinforced concrete pads.
- 6. Little Miss Muffet Child Care Center, Building No. 4008 and 4009
 - a. The licensed contractor shall visit the site location and take all measurements of the door heights for required slopes.
 - b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing vegetation and two (2) existing wooden porch coverings.
 - c. When the existing wooden porch structure and covering is removed from the modular building, the licensed contractor shall inspect the condition of the existing horizontal wood frame support on the existing side of the modular building, for damage due to water moisture and structural cracks deterioration.
 - d. If the existing horizonal wood frame support is damaged, the contractor shall remove the existing wood frame support, including fastener materials and disposal of all damaged materials.

i. The licensed contractor shall secure and anchor the two (2) new metal porch structures to the new concrete footings.

7. Many Farms Child Care Center, Building No. 4021

- a. The licensed contractor shall visit the site location and take all measurements of the door heights for required slopes.
- b. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing metal stairs and wheelchair ramp.
- c. The licensed contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing vegetation, existing concrete footings, and one (1) existing wooden porch covering.
- d. When the existing wooden porch structure and covering is removed from the modular building, the licensed contractor shall inspect the condition of the existing horizontal wood frame support on the existing side of the modular building, for damage due to water moisture and structural cracks deterioration.
- e. If the existing horizonal wood frame support is damaged, the contractor shall remove the existing wood frame support, including fastener materials and disposal of all damaged materials.
- f. The licensed contractor shall install new wood frame support, new fasteners, new materials, and match the existing wood frame support dimensions.

- S. **SPECIAL CLAUSES:** Pursuant to Section 507 PL 106-113, Special Clauses: The grant agreement requires disclosure of (1) the percentage of the total costs of the program or project which will be financed with Federal money (2) the dollar amount of Federal funds for the project or program, and the (3) percentage and dollar amount of total costs of the project or program that will be financed by nongovernmental sources.
 - 100% of total cost of this RFP will be financed with ACF-DHHS CCDF Grant Funds
 - Upon award and acceptance, the total dollar amount will be made available
 - Upon the contract with the awarded vendor.
 - None of this RFP will be funded by outside sources.
- T. **TERMS:** The term of this contract will be approximately 6 (six) months, from date awarded, with option for negotiable contract or a purchase order that will requires mutual agreements between both parties.
- U. **PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS:** All proposals must have as a minimum, the capabilities listed herein and the bid proposal submitted must reflect in detail the inclusion of these services as well as the degree of expertise in utilizing these capabilities.
 - 1. Licensed, bonded, and current General Liability Insurance.
 - 2. Prospective recipient shall sign a **Navajo Nation Debarment and Suspension** Waiver form, to be provided by DCCD.
 - 3. Must Submit Listing and provide all Licenses (AZ & NM), Certification, Awards, Degree with Proposal
 - 4. Prospective recipient shall sign a Tax Form W9 (2024)
 - 5. Navajo Nation Business Regulatory Certificate of Good Standing
 - 6. Statement on Navajo Nation Tax Compliance
 - 7. Certification of good standing from all State licensing offices
 - 8. One copy of comprehensive safety plan
- V. **INDEMINIFICATION**: To the fullest extent permitted by law, or as otherwise defined in the Contract, the successful Vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Navajo Nation and its officials, employees and agents from and against all claims, liens or demands that result in losses, liabilities, defense costs and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees and costs of litigation) arising out of the term, conditions and performance under the contract. The Vendor further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Navajo Nation, its agents, or employees, against claims or liability arising from or based upon the violation of any federal, state, county, city, or other applicable laws, bylaws, ordinances, or regulations by the Vendor, its agents, associates, or employees. The indemnification provided above shall obligate the Vendor to defend at its own expense or to provide for such defense, at the Navajo Nation's option, of any and all claims of liability and all suits and actions of every names and description that may be brought

against the Navajo Nation which may result from the operations and activities under any Contract resulting from this RFP. The award of this Contract to the Vendor shall obligate the Vendor to comply with the foregoing indemnity provision

BILLING AND PAYMENT:

1. Billing and payment shall conform to all Navajo Nation procurement procedures. In order to receive timely payment, vendor must have an obligation and responsibility to present invoices that are timely and accurate. An original of a vendor's invoice is needed for payment. The invoice must also contain identical information as shown on the purchase order or contract.
