Rejection of Proposals

The Navajo Nation reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the RFP, or reject any or all proposals, whenever such rejection is deemed in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture is soliciting sealed bids from qualified vendors to purchase two (2) heavy duty pick-up trucks for programs to use. The Tribal Ranch Program and Horse Management Program has 8 field staff and 5 overused vehicles for field work. Both programs respond to priority calls such as livestock round-up, livestock transportation, livestock seizures, and tribal ranch site visits across the Navajo Nation. Currently, both programs are sharing the vehicles and doubling up but with the 2 new heavy duty pick-up trucks, program staff will be able to respond to livestock related calls using reliable transportation.

- A. **REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS:** Bidders responding to this solicitation shall ensure the equipment proposed meets the following requirements:
 - 1. Equipment shall be new.
 - 2. Equipment shall meet the minimum specifications defined in Attachment 1 of this solicitation. Deviations to these specifications shall be clearly noted in accordance with Instructions to Bidders section, paragraph U. below.
- B. WARRANTY: The manufacturer's published warranty shall be documented in the bid. The price for a 5-year Extended Warranty must be included as a separate cost item in the response. The Bidder shall explain the specific coverage of each Warranty, including where maintenance covered under the Warranty will be performed.
- C. **SHIPPING AND DELIVERY:** The two (2) heavy duty pick-up trucks 2025 RAM 3500 Dually Tradesman Crew Cab 4X4 8' Box is expected to be delivered to the Navajo Nation within 60 days after receiving a signed Purchase Order.

The Navajo Nation shall take delivery of the equipment (trucks) at the Department of Agriculture, HWY 264 Navajo Nation Fair Grounds Building #121D, Window Rock, Arizona 86515.

At time of delivery, equipment training, vehicle title, warranty, operating manuals, and other licensing documentation shall be included.

Shipping and delivery costs are considered the responsibility of the bidder and shall be included in the bid proposal.

D. INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE: Inspection and Acceptance of each equipment (truck) shall be performed by the receiving Department of Agriculture programs at time of delivery. The Bidder(s) shall coordinate three business days in advance of each delivery to ensure the programs will have representatives available to perform the Inspections and Acceptance.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- A. **ISSUING OFFICE**: This Request for Proposals (RFP) is issued for the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture, PO Box 4889, Window Rock, Arizona 86515.
- B. **PURPOSE:** This RFP provides prospective proposals with sufficient information to enable them to prepare and submit for consideration.
- C. **SCOPE:** This RFP contains the instructions governing the proposals to be submitted and the materials to be included therein; mandatory requirements which must be met to be eligible for consideration and other requirements to be met.
- D. **INQUIRIES:** Prospective proposals may make telephone or written inquiries concerning this RFP to obtain requirement clarifications. No inquiries will be accepted after the inquiry deadline of **February 12, 2025** as listed on Page 2.
- E. **ADDENDUM OF SUPPLEMENT TO THIS REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS:** In the event that it becomes necessary to revise any part of the RFP, an addendum will be issued.
- F. PROPOSALS SUBMISSION: Proposals must be received on or before 5:00 pm MST, February 14, 2025. Respondents who are mailing their proposals should allow sufficient time for mail delivery to ensure receipt by the date specified. If mailed, it is recommended that proposals be sent by certified mail to the address indicated on Page 1 of the RFP. LATE PROPOSALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- G. **FOUR SETS OF PROPOSALS ARE REQUIRED.** The **original and three copies** must be delivered in a sealed envelope. The outside of the envelope should be clearly marked:

Name and address of the business submitting the proposal to be written legibly on the outside of the sealed envelope. The RFP bid/costs must be submitted in a separate envelope and must be sealed. This envelope should be marked "DO NOT OPEN".

- H. **BUY AMERICAN ACT:** The bid (proposal) shall include a statement in the letter of interest that the equipment complies with the requirements of the Buy American Act.
- I. **FULLY LICENSED DEALERSHIP:** Bidders must be an authorized and fully certified licensed equipment dealership that meets all the standards and qualifications required by the equipment manufacturers. All bidders shall include a statement certifying their Dealership licensing.
- J. PREFERENCE OF NAVAJO AND INDIAN-OWNED BUSINESS: Preference of Navajo and Indian-owned business will be given under the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act, 5 N.N.C. § 201 et. seq. and the Navajo Nation Procurement Act 12 N.N.C. § 303.

Certification of Navajo Owned Business will be assured by certificate held by the Navajo Business Regulatory Department. It is the responsibility of the offeror to identify themselves as certified under the Navajo Nation Business Opportunity Act in the letter of interest. As specified in the previous paragraph, vendors must demonstrate they are certified dealerships.

- K. AWARD OF BID / REJECTION OF BID: The Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture reserves the right to reject any or all bids/proposals and to waive informalities and minor irregularities in the proposals/bids received. At the time of acceptance, the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture also reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities of any item at the same price bid.
- L. **PROPRIETARY INFORMATION:** Any restrictions on the use of data contained within any proposals must be clearly stated in the proposals itself. Proprietary information submitted in response to this RFP will be handled in accordance with the applicable purchasing procedures. Each and every page of the proprietary material must be labeled or identified with the word, "PROPRIETARY."
- M. **RESPONSE MATERIAL OWNERSHIP:** All material submitted regarding this RFP shall become property of the Navajo Nation and will not be returned to the business.
- N. **INCURRING COSTS:** The Navajo Nation Purchasing Service Department and the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture are not liable for any costs incurred by the proposal prior to issuance of a contract.

- O. ACCEPTANCE OF PROPOSAL CONTENT: The contents of the successful proposal will become a contractual obligation if acquisition action ensues. Failure of the successful bidder/business to accept these obligations may result in the cancellation of the award and such proposal may be removed from consideration for future solicitations. The Navajo Nation Purchasing Service Department and the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture reserve the right to pursue appropriate legal action in the above set of circumstances.
- P. **ACCEPTANCE TIME:** The Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture intends to make a vendor selection within 5 days after the closing date.
- Q. **AWARD OF BID:** Upon selection, a purchase order and/or contract document will be prepared for the contractor and the proposal submitted by the contractor will become part of the purchase order and/or contract.

R. EVALUATION PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA:

- I. A Review Committee will review and will evaluate the proposals received in accordance with the general criteria used herein. Proposals should be prepared to provide any additional information that the team believes is necessary for a fair evaluation of proposals.
- II. Failure to provide any information requested in the RFP may result in disqualification of the proposal. All proposals must be endorsed with the signature of a responsible official having the authority to bind the proposal to the execution of a contract.
- III. The sole objective of the Review Committee will be to select the proposal that is most responsive to the needs of the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture. The specifications in this RFP represent the minimum performance criteria necessary for a response. On the basis of the evaluation criteria established in this RFP, the Review Committee will select and recommend the proposal that best meets this objective.
- IV. Evaluation Criteria: The following criteria will be used by the Review Committee in the selection process for the purchase order and/or contract award.
 - a. Letter of interest that includes the proposer's experience and capabilities in delivering the identified equipment/services listed in the Scope of Work and sections within the RFP to the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture. (20 points)

- b. Responsiveness of and organization of the written proposal to the purpose and scope of work. Completeness and clarity of all required information and any supplemental information provided by the proposer. This includes responses to where information is requested in the Scope of Work and Instructions to Bidders sections. (25 points)
- c. COSTS and specifications submitted for requested goods and services inclusive of all costs identified throughout the RFP. (20 points)
- d. Proposer must include in their RFP a list of three (3) references (organizations), including points of contact. The organizations may be contacted to determine the quality of work, delivery of services and quality of services. (15 points)
- e. Responsiveness to and submission of documents mentioned in Proposal Requirements below. (20 points)
- V. Cost/Price Factors: The importance of cost factors in the selection will depend upon the magnitude of the cost differentials identified, the credibility of such differential, the keenness of competition in the Technical Proposal, and the impact of other factors. The burden of proof as to cost credibility rests with the offeror. Proposed costs will be evaluated not only to determine if the estimate is reasonable, realistic and cost effective, but also to determine the offerors' understanding of the program and ability to organize and perform the contract. Cost/price factors will not be numerically weighed and scored.
- S. **WITHDRAWAL OF BID:** No bid/proposal shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 calendar days after the submission of the bid without the consent of the owner.
- T. **RETURN OF PROPOSALS:** The Navajo Nation has no obligation to return any proposals/bids received in response to this RFP.
- U. **DEVIATIONS:** All specifications listed in Attachment 1 are intended to be the preferred design and performance requirements. Where deviations from the specifications are necessary, Bidder will annotate equivalent reliability or performance. If there is insufficient room for detailing a deviation, please indicate "see deviation" and attach, clearly indicating the requirement on any such attachments. Failure to detail all such deviations will provide a basis for rejections of the entire proposal. Substantial deviations will not be considered.
- V. **TERMS:** The term of this purchase order and/or contract will be made in the best interest of the Navajo Nation Department of Agriculture with a contract or a Purchase Order that will require mutual agreements between both parties.

- W. **PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS:** All proposals must have as a minimum, the capabilities listed herein and the bid proposal submitted must reflect in detail the inclusion of these services as well as the degree of expertise in utilizing these capabilities. The following is a list of exhibits that are attached and are a bidding part of this RFP:

 - 2. Prospective recipient shall sign a Navajo Nation Debarment and Suspension Waiver Form.

- X. **TAXES:** All appropriate taxes should be included in cost of services including the Navajo Sales Tax. All work performed within the territorial jurisdiction of the Navajo Nation is subject to the Navajo Sales Tax of 6% (24 N.N.C. Section 601 *et. seq.*).
- Y. **SOVEREIGNTY:** The Navajo Nation will not relinquish any of its sovereignty rights.

BILLING AND PAYMENT:

Billing and payment shall conform to all Navajo Nation procurement procedures and rules and regulations. In order to receive timely payment, vendor has an obligation and responsibility to present invoices that are timely and accurate. *An original vendor invoice is needed for payment*. The invoice must also contain information as shown on the purchase order and/or contract.

Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Contracting Eligibility

- 1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - i. Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract,
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - iii. Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
- 2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
- 3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
