The Navajo Nation Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program is requesting for Proposal from all qualified engineer or architectural firm with contractors for assessing and testing the existing Modular Office Building and then renovate the building under codes in Tuba City, Arizona. Original sealed proposals with itemize cost, including all submittals and, clearly marked “**PROPOSAL FOR THE TUBA CITY AML OFFICE BUILDING PROJECT**” are due at 4:30 p.m. (D.S.T.) on Friday, March 13, 2026 at the Navajo Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program, Tuba City AML Office in Tuba City, Arizona or by mail to P.O. Box 730 Tuba City, Arizona 86045. The project location is in Tuba City, Arizona, within Navajo Nation.

The Scope of Work consists of assessing and testing the Modular Office Building and replace or upgrade roofing, installed walk-in shower and upgrade the flooring in the bathrooms, install a kitchenette, installing a new sewer line, install new skirting around the building, upgrade and repaint the exterior shell, improve the site drainage and properly dispose all waste all within budget. Also provide temporary secure storage units onsite.
