CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE INVITATION FOR BID (SCOPE):

Offeror must have experience with designing and building boat ramps in riverine systems. Offeror must provide qualifications and experience to design and build a boat ramp in a riverine environment.

Navajo Preference applies but does not guarantee Bid Award.

The Navajo Nation is not bound to enter into a contract under this RFP and may issue a subsequent RFP for the same purchase. Since the Navajo Nation is a sovereign government, all contracts entered shall comply with Navajo Nation Law, rules and regulations, as well as federal laws, rules and regulations.

The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government and all contracts entered into as a result of this RFP shall comply with Navajo Nation Law, rules and regulations, including the Navajo Preference in Employment Act, and applicable federal laws, rules and regulations.

Bid shall be effective on the date of award.

The payment procedures established by the Division of Finance shall be adhered to and are to begin whenever goods are delivered and accepted.

What's New

This change is intended to provide a flow-through entity with information regarding the status of its indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries, so that it can satisfy any applicable reporting requirements. Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and
Contracting Eligibility

1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:
 - A. Been convicted of the commission of criminal offenses incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of any such contract or subcontract;
 - B. Been convicted of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or other offenses indicating a lack of business integrity or honesty, which currently, seriously, and directly affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor;
 - C. Been convicted under antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - D. Violated contract provisions, including:
 - i. Deliberate failure, without good cause, to perform in accordance with the contract specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract,
 - ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance with the terms of any contract, or
 - iii. Any other cause so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Navajo Nation contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity.
2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
