The Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife is requesting proposals from qualified contractors to install a pipeline from Yonder Well to Nigh Well and to pull the well and install a solar pump in Old Homestead and Yonder Wells.

Work to be performed includes:

- 1. Trench and install pipeline from Yonder Well to Nigh Well. The pipeline is approximately 2 miles in length and runs along the fence line P348 which has already received archaeological clearance.
- 2. Pull well and install solar pump and panels at Yonder Well.
- 3. Pull well and install solar pumps at Homestead Well.

The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government and all contracts entered into as a result of this RFP shall comply with Navajo Nation Law, rules and regulations, including the Navajo Preference in Employment Act, and applicable federal; laws, rules and regulations.

The payment procedures established by the Division of Finance shall be adhered to and are to begin whenever goods are delivered and accepted.

- 1. Applicant entity acknowledges that to the best of its knowledge that the Applicant entity, either in its present form or in any identifiable capacity, has not, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 361:

- 2. Applicant acknowledges that if the Navajo Nation determines that the executed Certification provided herein is untrue or not wholly accurate, it shall be grounds for the Navajo Nation to terminate the contract and pursue other legal remedies, at the Navajo Nation's discretion.
- 3. Applicant certifies to the best of its knowledge that it is eligible to do business with the

Navajo Nation, in its present form or in any other identifiable capacity, pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 1501 and 5 N.N.C. § 301. Applicant also acknowledges that per 12 N.N.C. § 1505, it will not be eligible to contract with the Navajo Nation if deemed ineligible by the appropriate department or entity of the Navajo Nation which receives the Applicant's request for consideration for a business opportunity.
