The Navajo Nation Surplus Vehicle Sale is open to all Navajo enrolled members and NN employees over the age of 18 years. The location and schedule are as follows:

Eligibility & Bidding Guidelines

- Open to enrolled Navajo Nation members and employees, aged 18+, with a valid Driver's License, and census number or employee AB number if non-Navajo.
- Each participant is allowed two (2) bid forms; more will be disqualified.
- This is a competitive bidding process and will be monitored daily. Any vehicle with three or more bids will be taken off the market on the following business day.
- Bids must be submitted <u>only</u> within the specified dates and times. Early or late submissions will be invalid.
- Prospective bidders are strongly encouraged to inspect vehicles in person before submitting a bid.
- On June 27th, the first day of bidding, you will be asked to present your ID for verification. We will not accept bids from a person substituting for another bidder.
- Bids will be time-stamped and deposited in the bid box after ID verification.
- The bid forms will not be retrieved once they're in the bid box.
- Successful bidders will be notified two or more business days following bid closure.
- All sales are in "as is" condition and are final.

Successful Winning Bidder

- The winner of the vehicle will be notified by phone after the vehicle bid closes.
- The winner has up to 24 hours after they receive the call to make a payment.
- Types of payments accepted: Money Order or Debit/Credit Card (made at the Cashier)
- There will be no Payroll Deductions for NN employees.
- Once payment is received, the Winner will complete paperwork in Fort Defiance at the Navajo Nation Property Management Department Office.
